Instead, damage key features like part of his beak, talons, and have some important feathers (especially on the wings & tail) removed or damaged, to show he isn't recognized as a falcon.

However, he still needs some of his feather, since he is going to practice flying with the young rooster & when they compare their wings with each other.



I found the falcon's colors too saturated.

Since he's an old character, his colors should be more dimmed or faded, similar to how our hair turns grey as we age.
